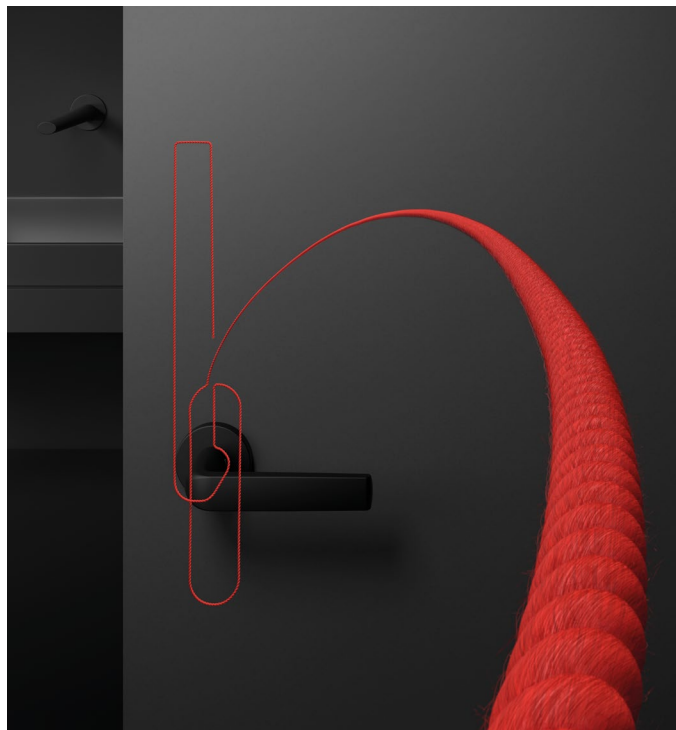

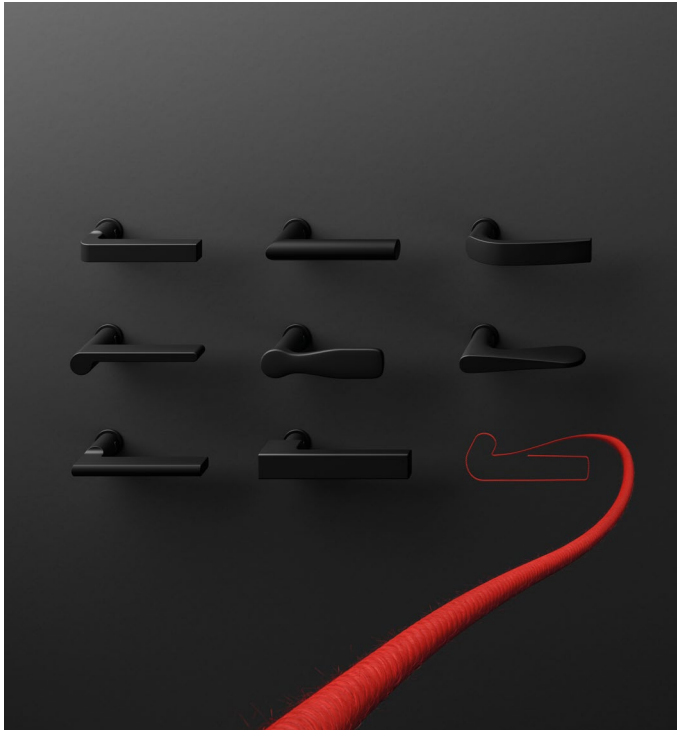
We understand consistency as a guideline for everything within our Lever Culture in architecture. This common thread will be apparent in this brochure as well as through all FSB product families.

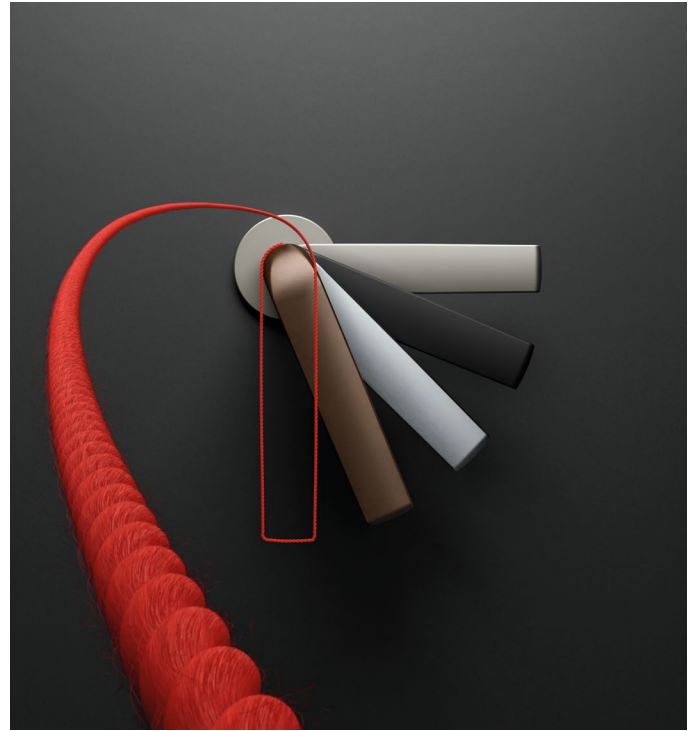

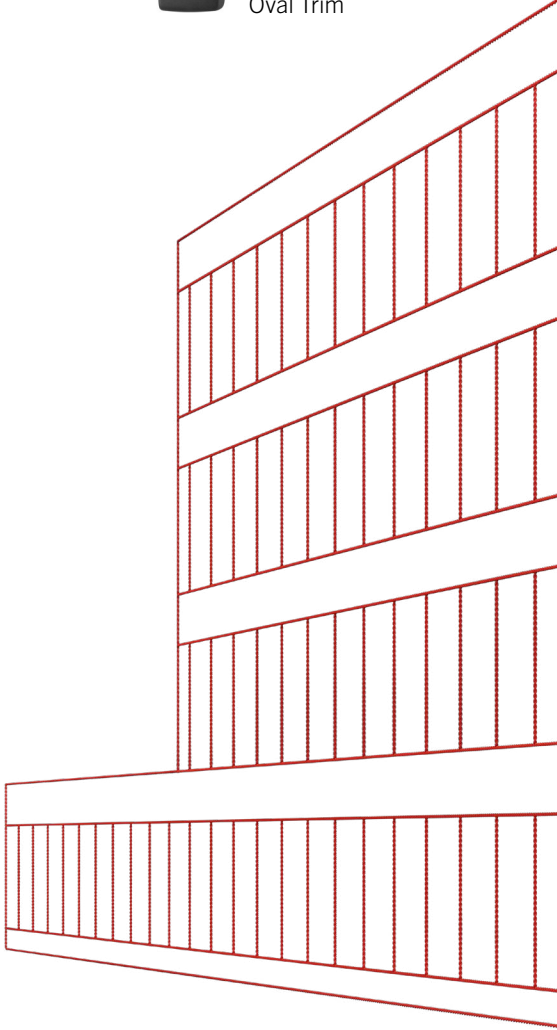

Oval Trim

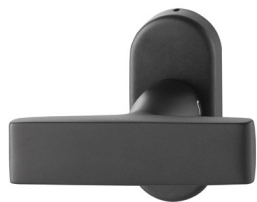

with return to door on RF Oval Trim





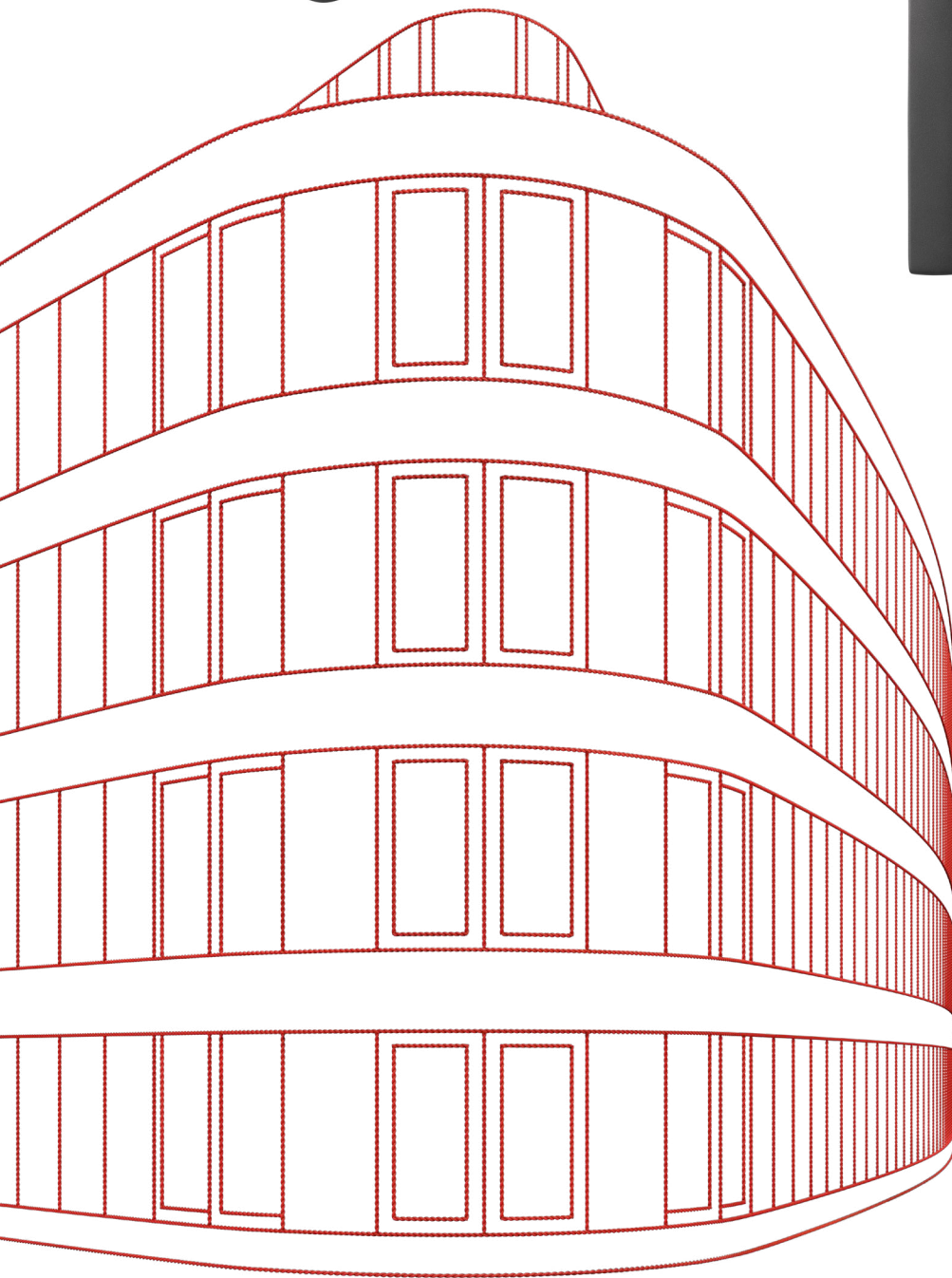
